### **III Expectations for the project from the Slovenian competent authorities**

During the mission we have held several meetings with the Slovenian competent authorities and the CAF in order to define their expectations to the activities of the project under component A, and present the ideas from Danish side.

The Danish Agricultural Advisory Service stressed the need for an open process securing that all relevant stakeholders take part in the production of the national guidelines, that the process should be bottom-up, and that the resulting guidelines should be operational on farm level.

The CAF agreed in these principles.

The DPD learned, that VARs and IRSAFF are both very important participants in the food and feed safety control system on farm level in Slovenia.

The project in relation to the competent authorities consists of two parts. On the one hand the validation of national guidelines, and on the other hand control strategy and planning of controls on farm level when national guidelines have been implemented. This last part of the project will be supplemented with on-the-spot training sessions.



#### **IV Experts recommendations**

On the basis of these findings the mission experts recommends a planning of the activities A.2, A.3, and A.4 as described in annex III to this report.
